

- 2. Exempted contractor/vendor personnel providing on-site services in patient care or procedural areas shall provide proof of a negative PCR test once every two weeks via email to their Facilities, Real Estate or Construction Project Manager.
- All exempted contractor/vendor personnel who wish to access NYULH facilities with a controlled entrance will be required to undergo the temperature check and symptom assessment. If the individual does not accept the screening protocols, or does not pass the screening tests he/she will not be admitted.
